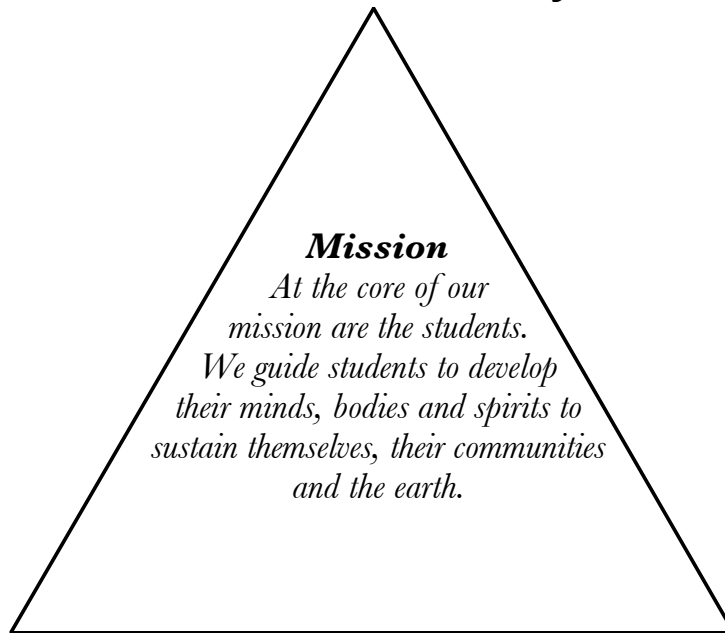


A Vision of Sustainability
